Position Overview

We seek an upbeat, passionate, and self-motivated instructor who can individualize lesson plans based on students' varying academic strengths and stretches. The Remedial Instructor will primarily provide one-on-one direct instruction in mathematics, but must also be able to support students in reading and writing. The ideal candidate will be professional, personable, and easy-going. Applicants must be fluent in English, connect with students of differing ages and abilities, and **teach mathematics up to a minimum of grade 9, reading (phonics, comprehension), and writing skills.**

Hours: 10 to 24 hours a week, with the potential for full-time employment in the future. Instruction occurs Monday to Friday between 9 am and 8 pm and Saturdays between 9 am and 5 pm. **Must be available to work evenings and Saturdays.**



Remuneration: \$28 - \$32 per hour. Benefits available for full and part-time employees: paid vacation time, generous extended health and dental benefits, professional development opportunities.
