
RISE and Shine


Build foundational academic skills and social learning in this summer intensive intervention.



Mornings: Each student receives RISE one-to-one instruction to build their literacy and numeracy skills.

Afternoons: Students build confidence with peers in fun social activities that support: social thinking, executive functioning, and fine motor skill development.

Intensive includes student assessments and reporting, including a level B KTEA-3 assessment before the start of the program (value of \$350).

Tutoring

Identify an area of need in literacy or math and receive tutoring to stay on track for school

Students sign up for 2 sessions each week for three weeks in a row. Sessions take place on either:

Mon/Wed **Tues/Thurs**

Total of 6 sessions from July 4-21 or August 8-25

Each tutoring session is 50 minutes

Sign up and purchase a block of tutoring sessions.

Sessions can be in the morning or afternoon.

Tutoring takes place online with limited in-person spots available.
