

Notice of Assessment (NOA)

What is a Notice of Assessment?

Your Notice of Assessment (NOA) is like a receipt for your taxes and is a practical and informative snapshot of your finances for the past year.

Why do I have to submit my Notice of Assessment?

Submitting your Notice of Assessment (NOA) is often required for funding applications to verify your income and financial status. This helps determine your eligibility for financial support.

How do I get a copy of my Notice of Assessment?

By mail after you have filed your taxes.

OR

Call 1-800-959-8281 to request a copy to be sent by mail.

OR

Use CRA's My Account (online) to view and print notices.

If you recently filed your tax return, you might not see your current year Notice of Assessment when you sign in to your CRA My Account or MyCRA. It can take between 2 to 16 weeks to receive your Notice of Assessment depending on where and how you submitted your tax forms.

How to get a copy of your NOA online:

Step One: Access the [CRA My Account website](#)

Step Two: Login using one of three methods


Sign-in Partner: Sign in with other online services like online banking.

CRA Login: Sign in with your CRA user ID and password.

Provincial Partner: Sign in using your provincial health card (BC and AB only).

Step Three: Click on Tax returns on the left-side navigation bar

Step Four: Click on “Notice of Assessment” for the most recent year
