

My Visit to LDS East Vancouver Learning Centre

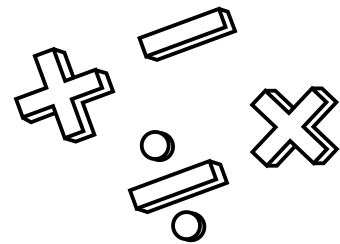
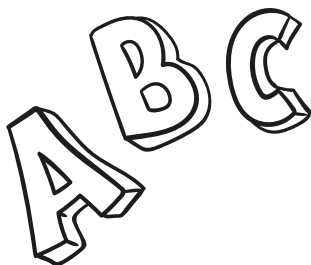
This story will help me know what to expect when I go for **one-to-one sessions!**

It is close to the **Rupert Skytrain Station and the 99 bus stop.**

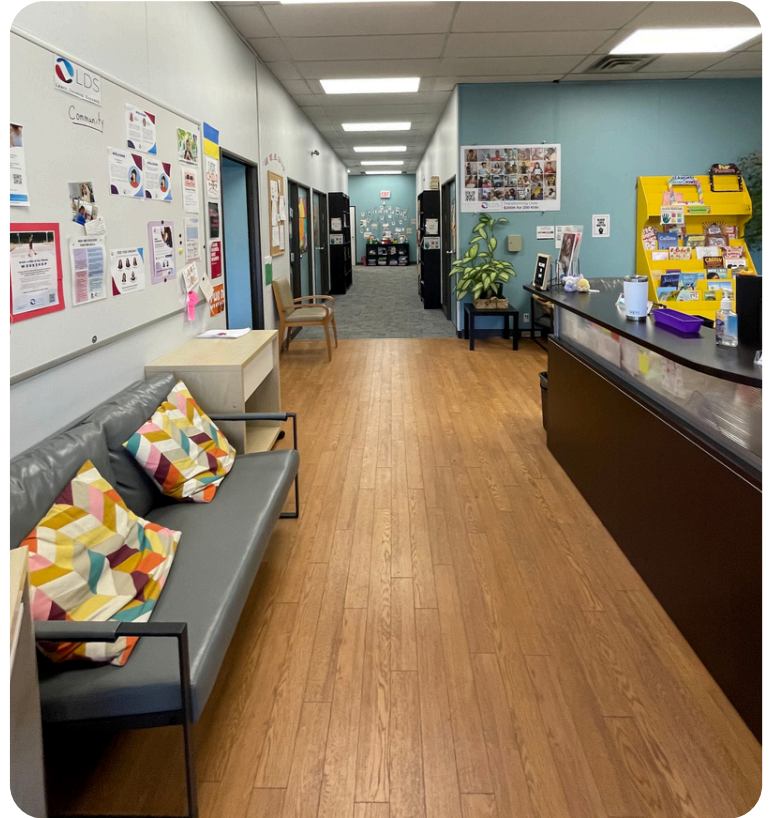
If someone drives me, we might park in front of the building.

I will wait in the lobby or the Assistive Technology (AT) Studio.

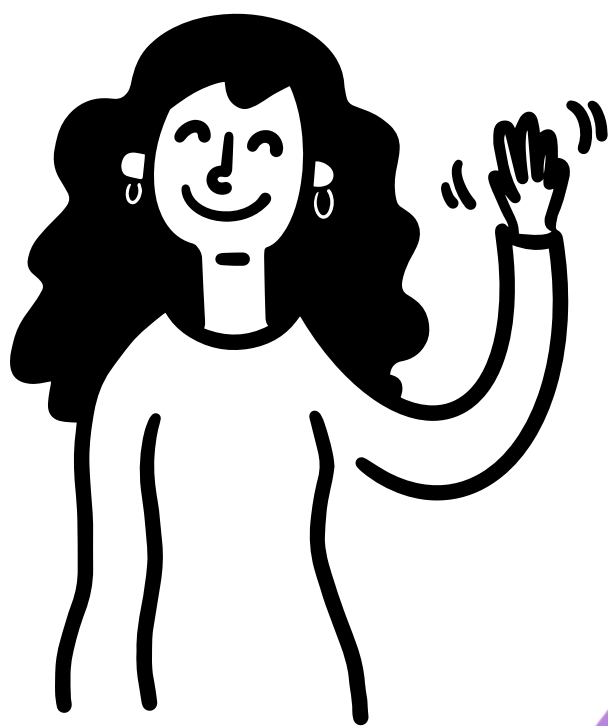
There are books, games, and colouring pages that I can use.

LDS has a lot of cool learning rooms!

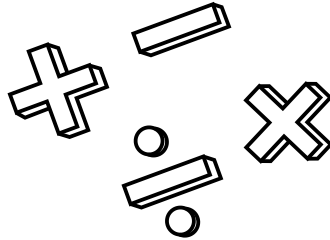
My lesson might be in:

- An upstairs instruction room
- One of the Pods
- The HIVE instruction rooms (downstairs)
- The Early RISers / Summer Camp Room

My instructor will show me where to go.



I will work with my instructor to get better at reading, writing, spelling, and math!



There will be a **schedule**, so I know what we are doing.

Some things might feel hard. That's okay!
I can do it, and my instructor will help me.



We will play games and take breaks, too.



If the lights bother me, there are lamps that make less light.

If I need help staying calm and focused, I can use tools like:

- **Fidget tools**
- **Weighted toys**
- **Wobble stools**



**If I need a break, I can tell my instructor.
They will listen and help me.**



There are **washrooms** upstairs and downstairs.

Everyone can use any of the washrooms.



There are also **kitchens** where I can:

- Fill up my water bottle
- Wash my hands



When the lesson is over, **my instructor will walk with me to the lobby**, and my parent or caregiver will pick me up!
