

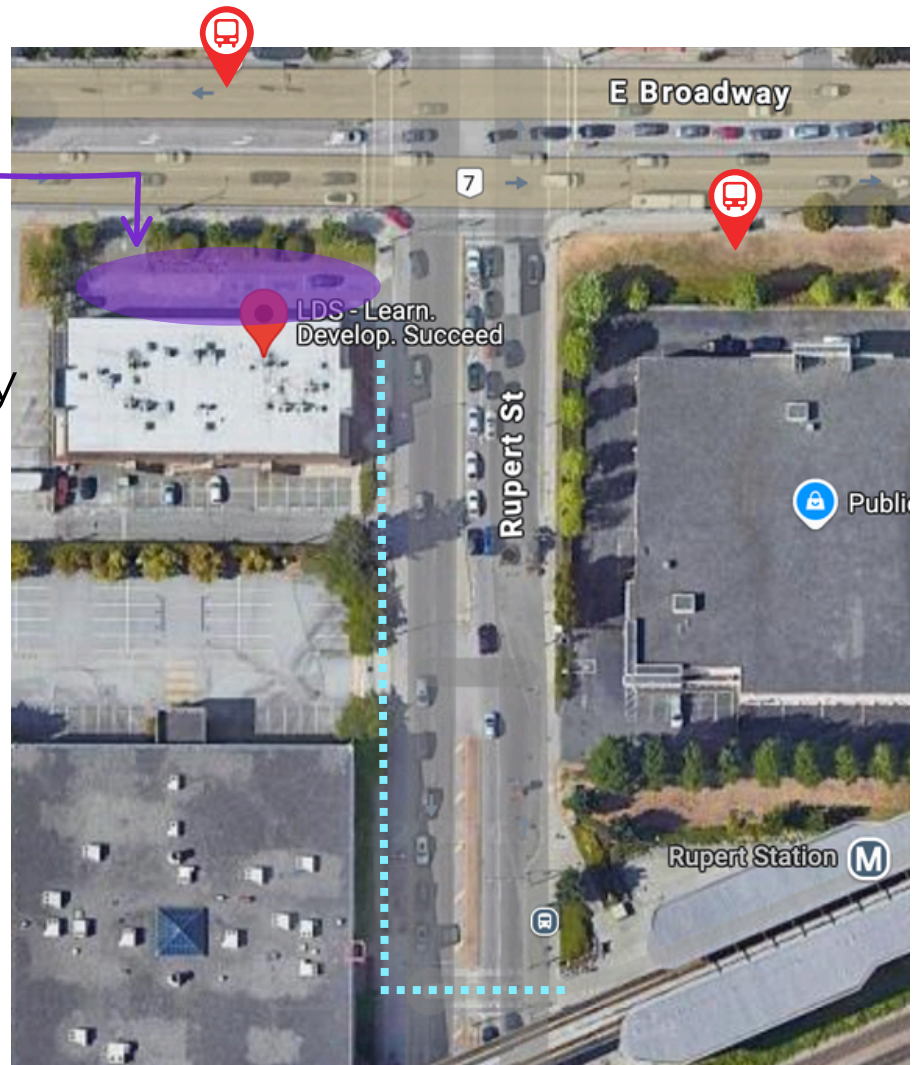
Welcome to LDS East Vancouver



This guide will help you understand what to expect when you come to the East Vancouver Learning Centre

LDS' East Vancouver office is at
3292 E Broadway (East Broadway & Rupert St.)

You can only enter
the parking lot
when driving east
on Broadway.
You can park in any
spot labelled 'LDS'.
on the ground.



It is a 3–5-minute
walk from the
Rupert Skytrain
Station or the 99
bus.

Sometimes, LDS Access is parked outside!





Come in through the front door. You will walk into the lobby.

You may see a staff member sitting at the front desk. If you have an appointment, tell them your name and who you are meeting.



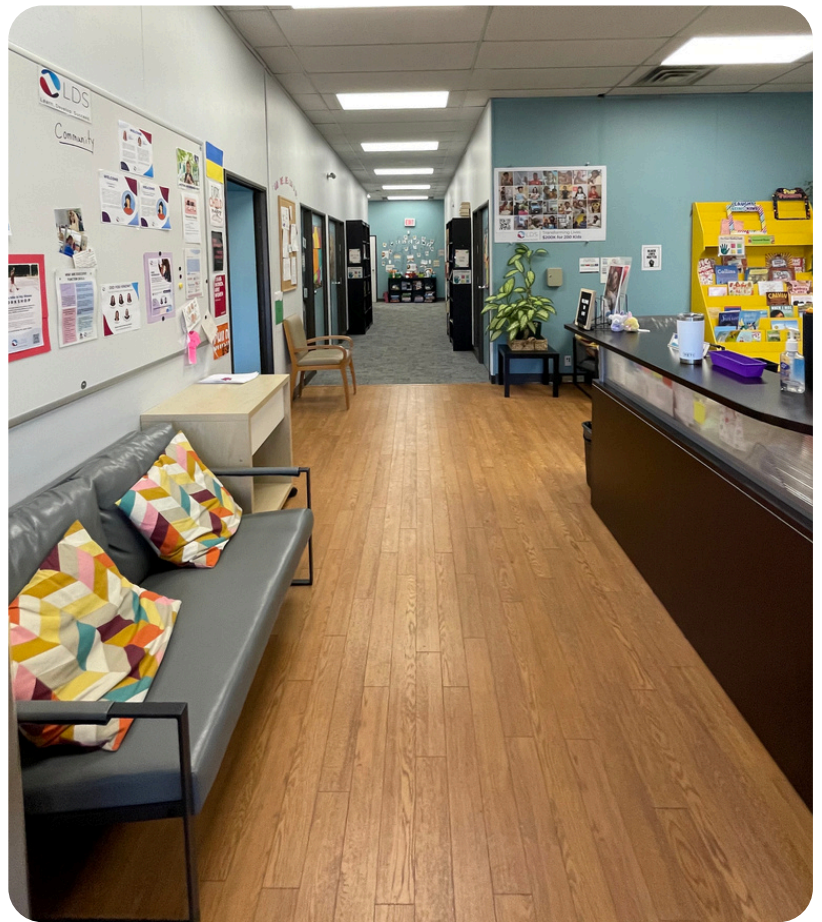
If no one is there, you can ring the doorbell on the inner door, and someone will come to greet you.



If you're here for a one-to-one session or a group program, your instructor or program leader will meet you in the lobby.

Please arrive no more than 5 minutes early!

The lobby can get busy, especially on weekday evenings during the school year.



For Parents and Caregivers:

If you're waiting during your child's session, you can:

- Stay in the lobby
- Wait in your vehicle
- Leave and come back within 5 minutes of pick-up

If other children are with you, please help keep the lobby calm and quiet. It is small and close to learning spaces.



There is an Assistive Technology (AT) Studio near the lobby.



You might use this room for learning with a smart board or other tools.

If you're waiting in the AT Studio or lobby, please stay quiet—others may be learning nearby.



The East Vancouver Learning Centre has many different instruction rooms and program spaces.

Your session or program could be in any of these places:

- **Upstairs instruction rooms**
- **Pods**
- **Early RISers / Summer Camp room**
- **HIVE instruction rooms (downstairs)**





There are four washrooms upstairs and one washroom downstairs.

The washrooms are for all genders.

There is also a kitchenette upstairs and downstairs to fill your water bottle or wash your hands.



LDS' learning spaces are sensory-friendly.

LDS is scent-free!

All the instruction rooms have lamps
if the overhead lights are too bright.



LDS has sensory tools like fidgets, weighted
toys, and wobble stools available.



Building Accessibility Information:

Some parts of the building are not wheelchair accessible.

There is a ramp to get onto the sidewalk at the end of the parking lot.

The front door is not automatic, and there are two doors to get inside.

Unfortunately, the washrooms and some doorways may not fit all mobility devices.
